# **School Uniform Policy**

## **SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY**

It is school policy that each child wears the school uniform and parents are asked to support the school in maintaining a high standard of appearance. We believe that school uniform helps us to develop sense of all belonging to our St. Christopher's school family. Following Government guidelines, we have reduced the expectation for badged items of uniform and we aim to make our school uniform as affordable as possible.

### **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

- \* white polo shirt (logo optional)
- \* grey trousers, shorts, grey skirt/pinafore dress
  - \* school sweater with badge
- \* polishable shoes/trainers(BLACK only)
- \* grey or white socks/tights



### **PE/SPORTS KIT**

- \* red t-shirt (logo optional)
- \* Royal blue shorts
- \* Suitable trainers or pumps.



\* A sports tracksuit is also available for colder weather but this is optional. Children can wear plain royal blue tracksuit bottoms and their school jumper over their red PE top for PE/sport during colder weather.

Children can wear their PE kit to school on their allocated PE day. This will be shared by your child's teacher and will be on the school website. PE kit should not be worn to school on non-PE days, unless prior permission has been given. For after-school clubs or events, children should bring their PE kit to school to change into at the end of the day.

This is the only stockist of our logo/badged items (jumper, cardigan, polo and PE kit) although other uniform items can be purchased at many high street shops and supermarkets.

## RULES REGARDING UNIFORM

As part of our policy on school uniform and appearance the following rules are also very important and are designed for reasons of health and safety, hygiene and the protection of personal property:

- Hair should be kept neat and tidy and if long it should be tied back only with a band or blue, white or red ribbons. This rule is vital if we are to combat the problem of head lice. If we notice that a child has head lice parents will be contacted and hair should be treated accordingly. Please speak to the school office or our pastoral team for advice.
- Shoes should be suitable for school purposes should be worn (e. g. no high heels or sandals).
- For health and safety reasons, jewellery is not allowed apart from small (no bigger than 3mm in diameter) plain studs or a watch (Children are not allowed to wear any form of smart watch for school. Any children wearing other jewellery or unsuitable accessories will be asked to remove them. Children may also be asked to remove earrings for certain physical activities. Pierced ears do not close over if earrings are not worn during the school day unless the ears have been newly pierced).
- Make-up of any description, including nail varnish, is not allowed and children will be asked to remove it immediately. False, stick-on or acrylic nails are not allowed for school under any circumstances.
- Please make sure that all of your child's clothing, including shoes, have fastenings that she or he can manage independently.
- All items of clothing and other personal belongings should be clearly marked with your child's name.
